I. Statement:

Requests for Access Service will be furnished insofar as the ability and facilities of this Telephone Company permit, in accordance with the following concurrences:

II. Concurrence:

GEETINGSVILLE TELEPHONE COMPANY, INC. hereby assents to, adopts and concurs in the rates, rules and regulations governing Access Service as they are set forth in Access Service Tariff I.U.R.C. No. 5 for Communications Corporation of Indiana, on file with the Indian Utility Regulatory Commission and makes itself a party thereto and obligates itself to observe the provisions therein with the following exceptions:

Single Line Business and Residence End User Access Service Rates and Charges.
Regulations, rates and charges for End User Access Service are provided for in Section VI, Sheet 4.

III. End User Access Service:

The Telephone Company will provide End User Access Service (End User Access) to end users who obtain local exchange service from the Telephone Company under its general and/or local tariffs.

A. General Description:

End User Access provides for the use of an End User Common Line (EUCL).

B. Limitations:

1. A telephone number is not provided with End User Access
2. Detail Billing is not provided with End User Access.
3. Directory listings are not included with End User Access.
4. Intercept arrangements are not included with End User Access.

C. Undertaking of the Telephone Company:

The Telephone Company will provide use of an End User Access at rates and charges as set forth in Section VI, Sheet 4, as follows:

1. Use of an EUCL by an end user, in connection with intrastate Access Services, is provided under this Tariff. Such use will be provided when the end user obtains local exchange service.
2. The Telephone Company will be responsible for contracts and arrangements with customers for the billing of End User Charges.

D. Obligation of the End User:

When the end user is a Radio Common Carrier (RCC), or a Maritime Radio Common Carrier (MRCC), it shall designate whether the local exchange services it is provided by the Telephone Company are used as access lines for its services or used as administrative lines.

E. Payment Arrangements and Credit Allowances:

1. Minimum Period:

The minimum period for which EUCL End User Access is provided to an end user and for which charges are applicable is the same as that in the general and/or local exchange tariffs for the associated local telephone exchange service.

2. Cancellation of Application:

End User Access is cancelled when the order for the associated local telephone exchange service is cancelled. No cancellation charges apply.

3. Changes to Orders:

When changes are made to orders for the local exchange service associated with End User Access, any necessary changes will be made for End User Access. No charges will apply.

4. Allowance for Interruptions:

When there is an interruption to an EUCL, requested End User Access credit allowances for interruptions will be provided as set forth for credit allowance for interruptions in Section II, Sheet 6, III preceding.

E. Payment Arrangements and Credit Allowances: (Continued)

5. Temporary Suspension of Service:

When an end user temporarily suspends its local exchange service which is associated with EUCL, one-half of the EUCL per month charge will be temporarily suspended for the time period the local exchange service is suspended.

F. Rate Regulations:

1. EUCL per month charges will be billed to the end user of the associated local exchange service.
2. For each local exchange service provided as remote call forwarding residential service or remote call forwarding business service under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs, End User Access charges do not apply.

For each local exchange service, other than local exchange service used for administrative purposes, provided to Radio Common Carriers and/or Maritime Radio Common Carriers as access lines for their services under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs, End User Access charges do not apply.

3. When an end user is provided more than one local business exchange service in a state by the same Telephone Company, other than that specified in (2) preceding, and when the local business exchange service is provided as semi- public service under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs, the End User Common Line (EUCL) Multi-Line Business Subscriber-Individual line or trunk rate as set forth in

F. Rate Regulations: (Continued)

3. Section VI, Sheet 4, following applies to each such semi-public local business exchange service.
4. When an end user is provided more than one local business exchange service in a state by the same Telephone Company, other than that specified in (2) preceding, and when the local business exchange service is provided under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs and is not covered by (E) (5) preceding, the End User Common Line (EUCL) – Multi-Line Business Subscriber – Individual line or trunk rate as set forth in Section VI, Sheet 4 following applies to each such local business service.
5. When an end user is provided a single local business exchange service in a state by the same Telephone Company, other than that specified in (2) preceding, and when the local business exchange service is provided as a multi-party service under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs, each party is deemed to be a user of an EUCL and the End User Common Line (EUCL) Single Line Subscriber – Individual line or trunk rate as set forth in Section VI, Sheet 4 following applies to each such party.

F. Rate Regulations: (Continued)

6. When an end user is provided a single local business exchange service in a state by the same Telephone Company, other than that specified in (2) preceding, and when the local business exchange service is provided under the general and/or local exchange service tariffs, the End User Common Line (EUCL) Single Line Subscriber – Individual line or trunk rate as set forth in Section VI, Sheet 4 applies to each single business service. Such local business exchange service includes a single semi-public business service or any other single local business exchange service not covered in (7) preceding.
